

After completing his studies and beginning his professional career, he met his wife Hazel, a U.S. citizen, and married and had two children, a daughter 14, and a son, 10 who has mosaic Downs syndrome. Emmanuel worked for an organization that supports children and adults with special needs. ICE arrested him in front of his son and he was detained at Moshannon. Emmanuel was recently released and is back with his wife and children, and is working to end his deportation threat. After being arrested, as the family's major breadwinner, his wife suffered emotionally and economically, trying to work additional hours and tend to their special needs son.
