DOCUMENT:

- Film, photograph, and note what you see, both to gather intelligence and to alert broader rapid response network of verified and time sensitive information

DISSEMINATE:

- Inform trusted networks of what you see using SALUTE.
- Do not post unverified information on social media!

DIRECT:

- Directly engage with the situation, informing compas of their rights to the maximum extent possible

DELAY:

- Challenge and obstruct ICE's operational tempo to buy time for rapid responders, media, lawyers, etc.

DISRUPT:

- Maximize the impact of individual and group actions to interrupt or undermine ICE's objectives.

Tuesday January 27, 2026 many people went into the cold and snow to rally at Philadelphia City Hall to hear faith leaders, politicians and immigrant rights advocates. After about an hour we marched (with drums and horns) to Senator John Fetterman's office. Earlier in the day an attempt was made to deliver a letter to him to vote NO on the upcoming bill to give more funds to CBP and ICE. No one received the letter, saying he only sees constituents through scheduled appointments.
