Let's Pack City Hall – ICE OUT

Monday in City Hall April 13, 2026 10 AM-4 PM

April 13, 2026, 10 AM-3 PM City Council assembly and proposed ICE OUT legislation. A gathering of pro-immigrant organizations and individuals gave their support to the proposals in January. for the Philadelphia City Council to consider. The proposals, in summary, would prohibit city agencies and contractors from providing ICE access to data sets to assist in immigration enforcement. On Monday, April 13th the City Council will convene to debate the proposals. Some members of the Council are wavering. So, it is urgent for many interested residents of Philadelphia to attend the deliberations on Monday starting at 10 a.m. and ending at 5 p.m. Come for the entire session or for any part of it that you can. The Council meets in the Council Chamber accessed on the fourth floor of the City Hall. The main entry to City Hall is at the northeast corner of the building across from the Masonic Lodge. You will need I.D. to enter. See attached flyer for more details and to let others know about this event.
